Re: Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act of 1986 (AHERA)

In accordance with recent Federal Regulations concerning asbestos, your Board has employed a consultant to conduct inspection services and to formulate an asbestos management plan in accordance with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act.

Asbestos is a known potential health hazard.

Asbestos Containing Materials (ACM) have been found in some of our buildings.

The ACM is currently in good condition and should not present a danger unless disturbed or damaged.

Our custodial and maintenance staff has received training and will follow an approved operations and maintenance program to assure that no student or employee will be exposed to asbestos fibers.

A copy of the AHERA Management Plan is available for your inspection at each school office and at the Superintendent's office. You may make copies of any portion of the plan or the entire plan at a nominal cost to you for reproduction of copies.
